“Fundamentals of crystallography”



Maria Gdaniec is now Professor in the Department of Chemistry of Adam Mickiewicz University and Head of the Laboratory of Crystallography in Poznań, Poland. She received her MSc in chemistry (1974) and PhD under the guidance of Prof. Zofia Kosturkiewicz (1978). She carried out post-doctoral research with Prof. L.H. Weith at Purdue University (1981-1982) and, as a Humboldt Fellow, at Stuttgart University with Prof. J. J. Stezowski (1983). Her research interests focus on structural and supramolecular aspects of chemistry, crystal engineering, X-ray crystallography. She is the author of more than 300 papers. Currently she is president of the Crystallographic Committee of Polish Academy of Sciences and co-editor of *Acta Crystallographica E*.
